Crews must not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes prior to their appointed time as stated. Additionally, crews must keep all vehicular noise to a minimum. Crews who produce excessive vehicle noise within Galvin Street will be referred to the Stewards.

All vehicles must be fitted with the tyres intended to be used on SS1.
A penalty of \$5.00 per minute will apply for any lateness.

Article 16. Running of the Rally

Change:

- a) A ceremonial start in which all crews & their vehicles must participate, will be held on Friday the 21st June from 1700hrs.

The organisers will locate a staging area for the ceremonial start, which is not considered a Parc Fermé, in the one hour prior to the ceremonial start of the Super Special Stage. Competitors are to ensure that their vehicle is placed in this staging area between 1500hrs and 1600hrs on Friday 21st June 2019 as per the following schedule:

Add:

Nominated ARC Crews are required to be in attendance at a poster signing session from 1630hrs to 1700hrs at the Roundhouse. Failure to attend will be referred to the Stewards of the meeting.

The Ceremonial Start of the Rally will be at 1705hrs on Friday 21st June at the Super Special Stage.

- I. Following the Ceremonial Start, crews will commence a warm up run over the stage and then re stage in the centre area of the Round Yard.
- II. Crews are permitted to run at competition speeds during their warm up lap.
- III. Upon completion of the warm up lap by all competitors, the timed run of SS1 will commence, with the slowest seed car starting first.

This permit is extended to permit the use of a remote piloted aircraft (RPA) by Benjamin Green and the holder of CASA RPA Controllers Certificate ARN: 1023192 and under RPA Operators Certificate ReOC: 0155
